Robert and Sean both go to the same church, go to the same school, and play on the same soccer team.



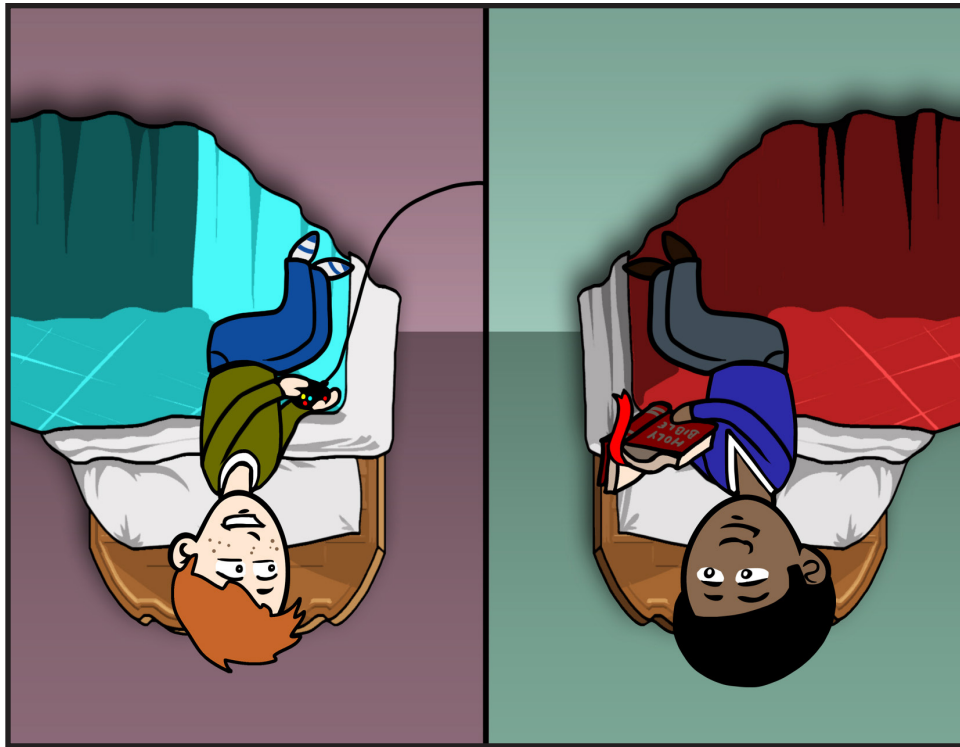
(Fold)

At school, Leonard has a plan to cheat on a test at school. Robert goes along and cheats on the test. Sean does not.



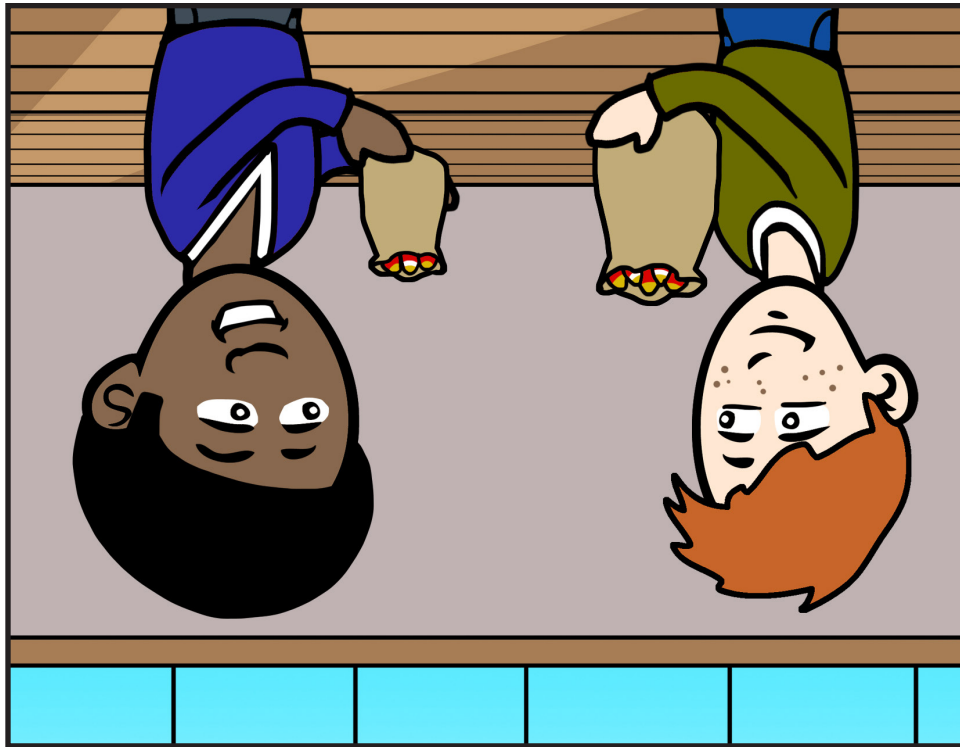
(Fold)
