



Family Activity

Gather your family together and remind them that God wants us to pray to Him. One way we can do that is to pray for each other. Have family members share one request with the group. Write each request on a card. Give each family member a card from another family member and encourage everyone to pray for that person's request through the week. Plan at least one family prayer time when you all gather and each person uses the card to pray for his or her assigned person's request. Check on family members throughout the week and make sure that they are spending a little time each day praying. Meet up again at the end of the week and talk about how it felt to have someone praying for you and how it felt to pray for someone else. See if any of the prayers were answered and repeat each week.

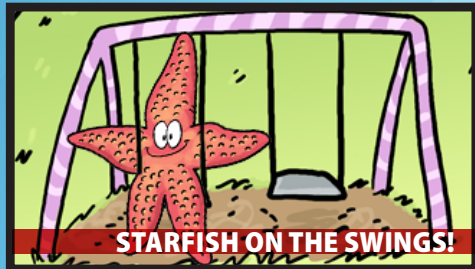
