

# Lesson 4

## I Will Tell The Truth!

**BIBLE VERSE:** "Truthful words stand the test of time, but lies are soon exposed." Proverbs 12:19 (NLT)

### What Is The Purpose Of These Activities?

#### PREP FOR BROADCAST (WEEKLY OPENING ACTIVITY)

This opening activity will introduce the children to the theme of the series and prepare them to learn the Main Point.

#### HEADLINES OR HEAD-LIES (OPENING ACTIVITY)

This opening activity will introduce the children to the lesson of the day.

#### SKIT AND BIBLE LESSON (LARGE GROUP ACTIVITY)

This Skit and Bible Lesson will teach the children that we should choose to tell the truth even when lying seems to be the easiest option.

#### TV FILM STRIP (WEEKLY REVIEW CRAFT ACTIVITY)

This activity will review the lesson with the children and help them share the lesson with others when they go home.

#### LESS LIES (SMALL GROUP APPLICATION ACTIVITY)

This activity will demonstrate that liars are actively avoided by others.

#### LIE LESS, LES (SMALL GROUP APPLICATION ACTIVITY)

This activity will show that even if lies work in the short term, they only bring trouble to your life.

#### THE WEIGHT OF LIES (SMALL GROUP APPLICATION ACTIVITY)

This activity will demonstrate how the guilt and consequences of lies build up until they are too heavy to bear.

#### REPORTER TRAINING (REVIEW GAME - LARGE GROUP ACTIVITY)

This is a strategic time to review and reinforce the content of the lesson.
