Malcom Story - Card #1

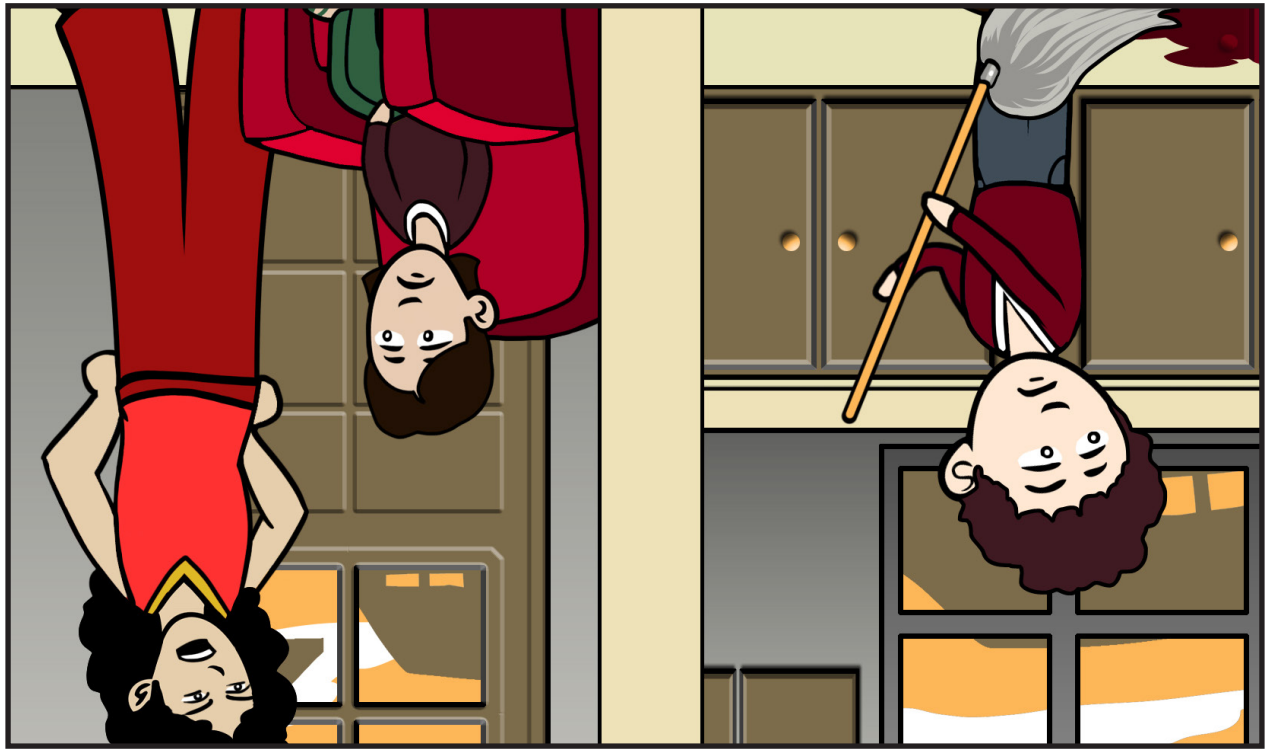

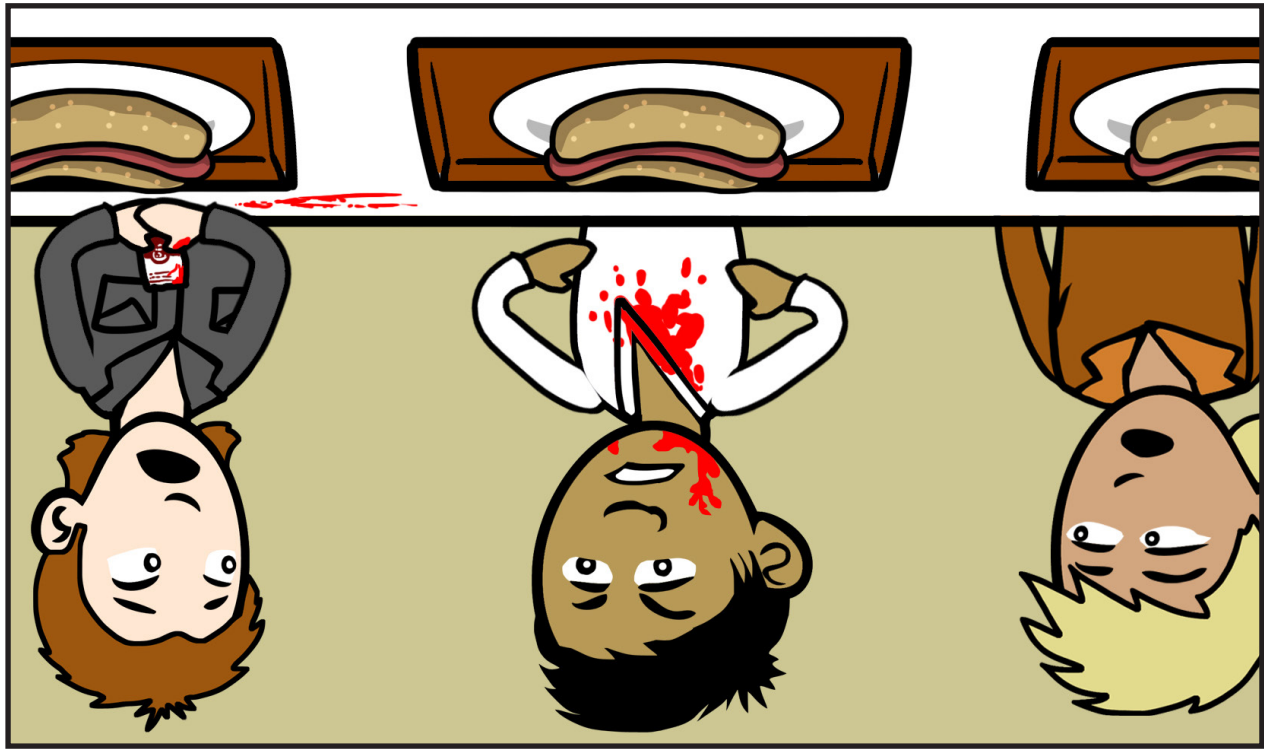

Warner Story - Card #1

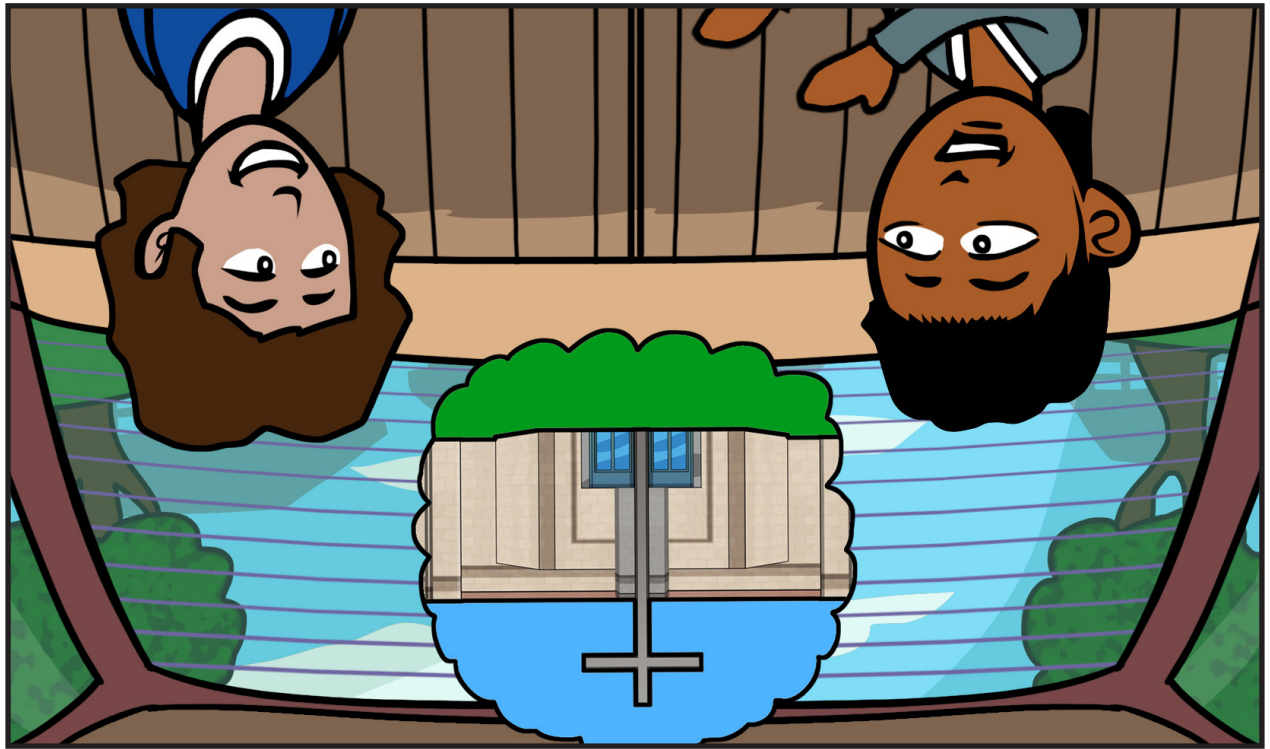
